



Ash-Shaykh 'Ubaydullaah ibn 'Abdus-Salaam ar-Rehmaanee al-Mubaarakpooree

He is ash-Shaykh al-'Allaamah, al-Muhaddith Abul-Hasan 'Ubaydullaah ibn 'Abdus-Salaam ar-Rehmaanee al-Mubaarakpooree, author of *Mir'aatul-Mafaateeh Sharh Mishkaat al-Masaabeeh*. Ar-Rehmaanee is an ascription to al-Madrasatur-Rehmaniyyah in Delhi (India).

He was born in the month of Muharram, the year 1327H. He first studied under his father ash-Shaykh 'Abdus-Salaam and completed his studies in five years in al-Madrasatur-Rehmaniyyah in Delhi, and studied under Ghulaam Yahyaa Kanfooree and Shaykh Ahmadullaah al-Hindee, and 'Arabic literature under ash-Shaykh Al-Haafidh 'Abdur-Rahmaan, as he also studied under ash-Shaykh 'Abdur-Rahmaan al-Mubaarakpooree from *Jaami'ut-Tirmidhee*, and the book *Uloomul-Hadeeth* by Ibnus-Salaah, and *as-Siraajiyah* in al-Faraa'id.

And he passed his studies at Madrasatur-Rehmaniyyah with honors and graduated in the year 1345H, and immediately following his graduation he was appointed by ash-Shaykh 'Ataa-ur-Rahmaan to Madrasatur-Rehmaniyyah, the same school he had graduated from.

And it is known that ash-Shaykh 'Abdur-Rahmaan al-Mubaarakpooree, the author of *Tuhfatul-Ahwadhee* [explanation of the *Jaami'* of Imaam at-Tirmidhee], went blind before completing the explanation, and was in need of a scholar who specialized in the sciences of Hadeeth to aid him in the completion of his explanation, so ash-Shaykh 'Ataa-ur-Rahmaan sent Shaykh 'Ubaydullaah ar-Rehmaanee, from his own money, to Mubaarakpooree to help him complete the explanation, so he stayed with him for two years until he completed the explanation of the book then he returned to Madrasatur-Rehmaniyyah to teach.

He authored many works from the most significant of them *Mir'aatul-Mafaateeh Sharh Mishkaat al-Masaabeeh*.

He died on 10/22/1414H in Mubarakpoor.
